The Dolly Parton Imagination Library program provides a new developmentally appropriate book each month to children between the ages of 0 and 5 years old. As of June 30, 2014, the United Way of Faribault had 513 children registered.



Health (Empowering Healthy Lives)

When people are in good health, the benefits ripple across our community. United Way focuses on these areas to keep people healthy and independent:
